3. Conference with Legal Counsel – Anticipated Litigation Significant Exposure to Litigation Government Code Section 54956.9 (b) (one case).

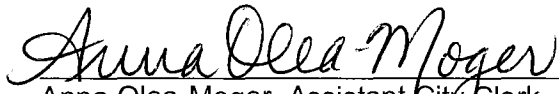
