Call to Order

1. Public Comment

Study Session Items:

2. Park and Open Space Design guidelines/Facilities Plan

Paul Junker, Planning Director and Consultant MIG gave a presentation.

Public input targeted the following issues as needing to be considered/taken into account in any design: light rail and open space; smaller lots that homes are being built on; need for renovating and adding new soccer facilities; budget for maintenance; above ground drainage and water quality; need for rugby fields; facilities for leagues and tournaments; upgrading aquatic facilities; sidewalks and bike lanes; dog parks; neighborhood parks; dealing with homeless; joint use facilities; flexible use; hope for destination facilities;

upgrading Hagan park; access by all to the new parks; indoor pool; that the 5 acre standard might not provide enough park space.

3. Park Renovation Fee Project Priorities and Funding Allocations as Presented by CRPD

There was Council and Board discussion. Next steps: Board to bring forward to Council a request for funding three master plans (Cordova Community Pool; Dave Roberts Community Park; Lincoln Village Park) and ADA renovations at six neighborhood parks.

4. Review of Current Grant Projects totaling \$6,651,786

A presentation was given by Charlie Rice.

5. Mather Sports Center Master Plan and Preferred Alignment of International Drive with Old Placerville Road

Jay Beals of Beals Alliance described the Mather Master plan process and plans for the Mather Sports Center renovation.

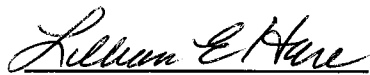
Ted Gaebler discussed the alignment of International Drive with Old Placerville Road. Its current configuration misses Mather Sports Center.
