2. Subject: Legislative Process

Recommendation: That Council:

- (a) Affirm a process that staff can use to act quickly on legislation, based on Council-set priorities.
- (b) Create a Council subcommittee to develop legislative priorities.
- (c) Consider hiring a State lobbyist during the 2007-2008 budget session.

Result of Recommended Action: Staff should receive clear direction on how to proceed when outside sources provide information regarding legislative affairs, and how to handle directives by outside agencies, professional organizations, and individual Council members about legislative advocacy. The discussion will be used as a basis for creating a legislative review process, accompanied by the development of legislative priorities and consideration of hiring a State lobbyist.

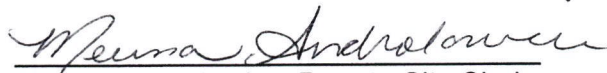
