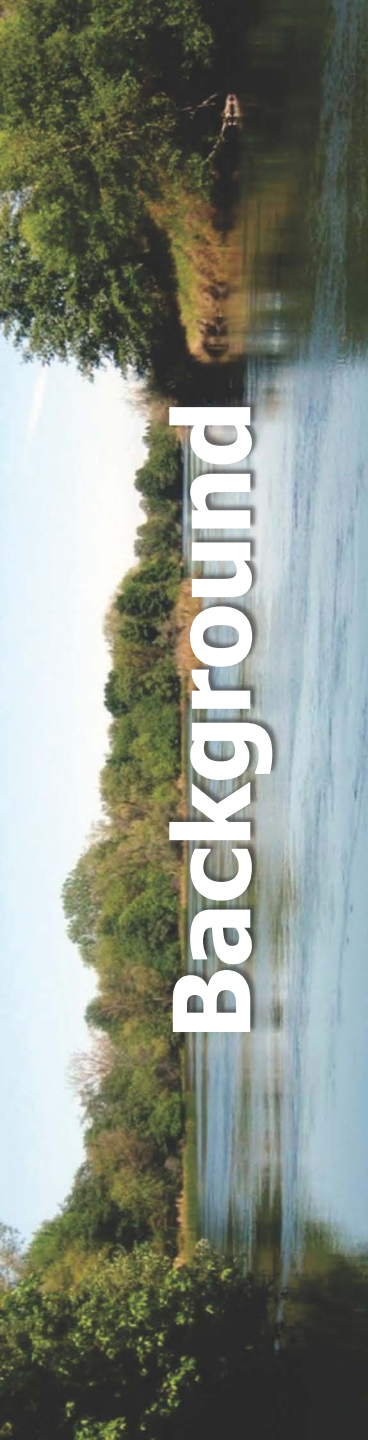

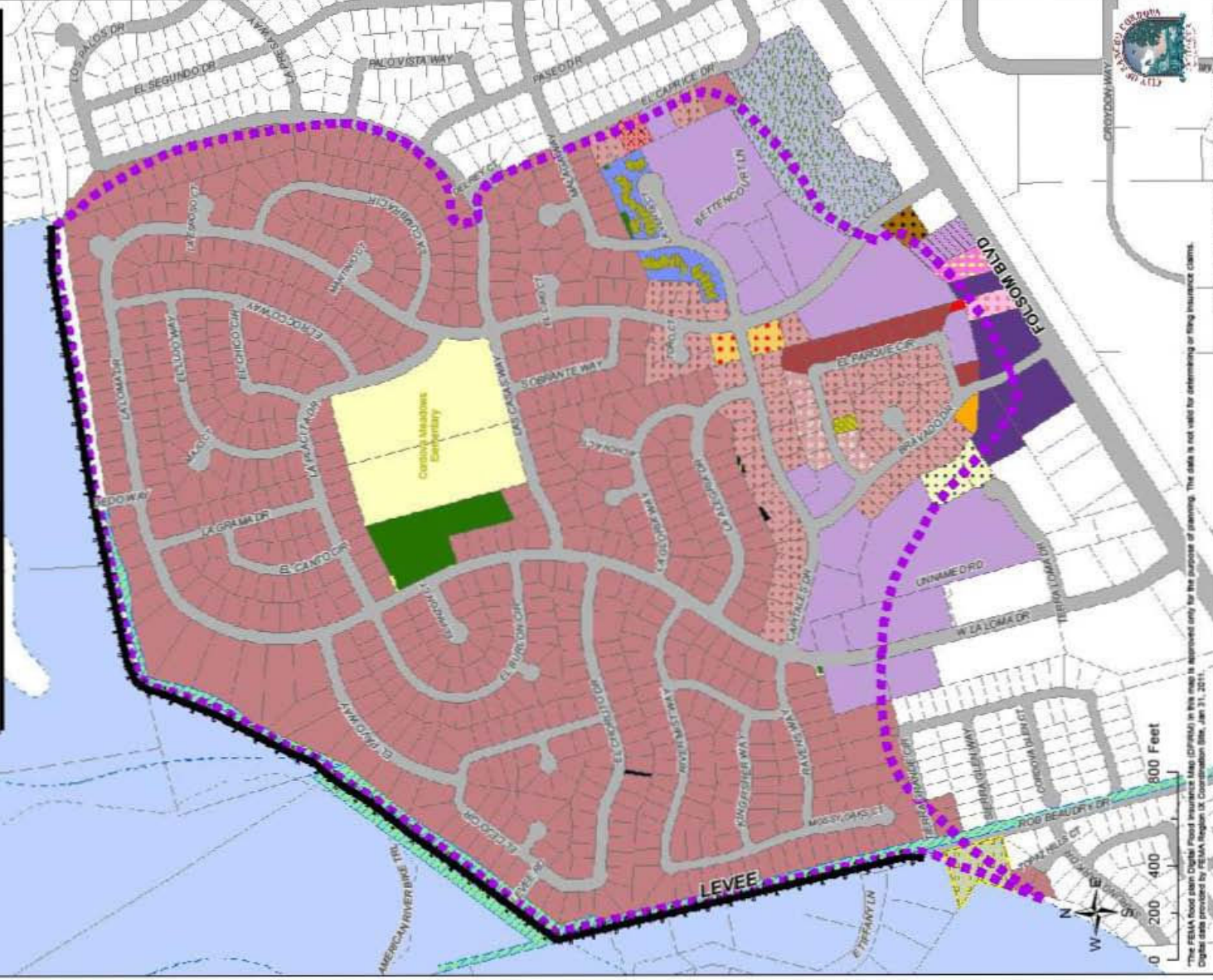

FEMA Preliminary Flood Zoning



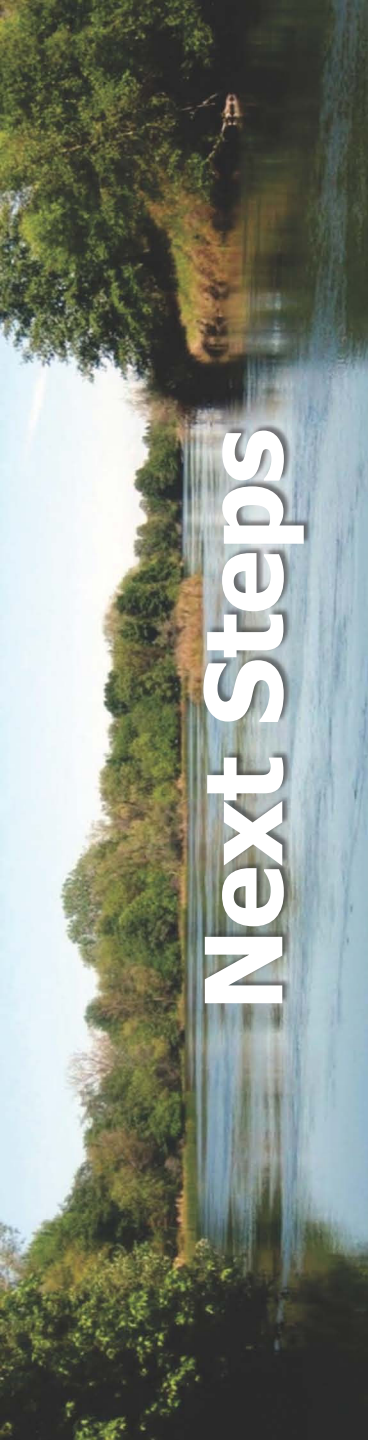
