Recommendation: Review the information provided by staff and:

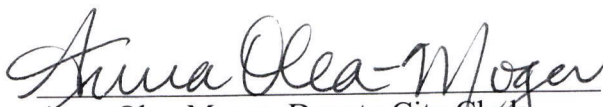
- Provide any comments necessary on the Vision Book and indicate concurrence with the draft Vision statements
