V. DISCUSSION

a. Career Technical Education (CTE) in FCUSD

Superintendent Swanson introduced Shanan Spears, Coordinator of Career Technical Education, to present this item.

Ms. Spears presented *From Classroom to Career, Designing Industry Aligned Pathways for Student Success* covering the following topics:

- Evolution of Vocational Education to CTE

- California's Career Technical Education—Preparing students for the 21st Century and Beyond: Industry Sectors and Key Components of CTE Pathways.
- CTE in FCUSD-Enrollment: 3,765 CTE Students 6th-12th grade; 37% HS and 20% MS students enrolled; 19 CTE Pathways in 11 Industry Sectors.
- CTE Pathway Completers data for 2024-2025: 388 students completed a pathway; 20 students completed two pathways by graduation.
- Expanded and New Potential CTE Pathways: Industrial Arts, Construction/Electrical/HVAC/Welding/Manufacturing, Emergency Medical Response, and AI/Data Science/Computer Sciences.

A request was made to provide all members with a chart outlining FCUSD's CTE programs at each high school. This information will be distributed electronically.

b. Artificial Intelligence (AI) in our Region

Superintendent Swanson introduced JP Morgan, Chief Innovation Officer for Human Machine Collaboration Institute (HMCI), to present this item.
